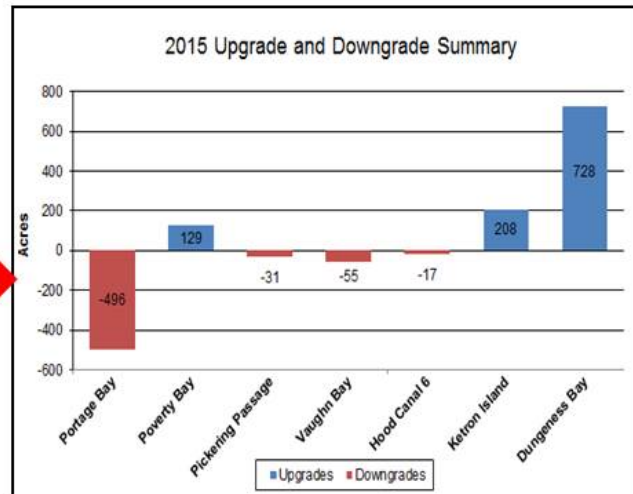
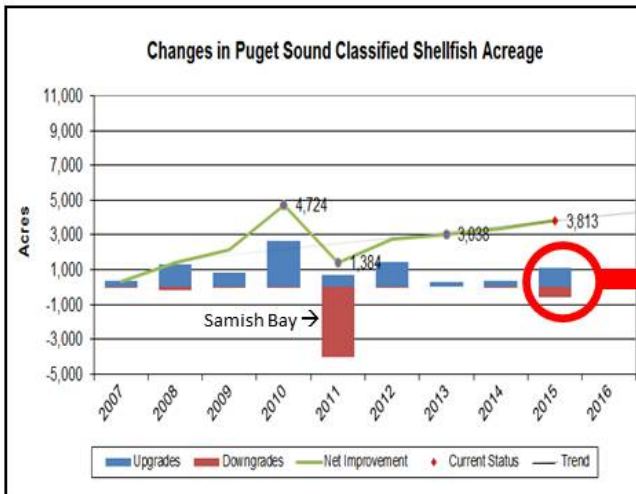

Actions Underway

- Shellfish Coordination Group work in Samish and Nooksack river watersheds
- Shellfish Protection District formation in Pickering Passage, Hood Canal 6, and Vaughn Bay growing areas
- \$1.9 million distributed in 2015 for PIC and septic projects

Barriers

- Insufficient farm waste management in some counties
- Lack of sustainable local nonpoint pollution programs
- Limited control of boaters' waste
- Difficulty implementing septic management and repair programs
- Wastewater plant outfalls to Puget Sound
