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PROJECT SHARE: BLT- Business-Led Transformation

This month's featured project involves Jennifer Renhard with Liberum, working with the Department of Corrections, to lead a multi-year implementation of an enterprise-wide ERP system. This is an 8-phase project currently underway with the goal of completing the transformation of operations and working roles for 80% of the agency. Some challenges have been COVID-19 timeline changes, maintaining engagement, and significant workload transition. Despite those challenges, this project has kept great momentum due to leadership commitment, communication plans, shared passion from team members, and joint ownership of project success.
