Keynote Speaker: Dr. Shelley Metzenbaum



Dr. Metzenbaum is president of the newly-formed Volcker Alliance. Its mission is to address the challenge of effective execution of public policies and to rebuild public trust in government. Dr. Metzenbaum most recently served as the Associate Director for Performance and Personnel Management at the White House Office of Management and Budget, serving at the forefront of the federal government's effort to make it leaner, smarter, and more effective. She managed the day-to-day implementation of the Obama Administration's approach to federal government performance management. She is recognized as one of the nation's leading experts in the field of performance management and measurement in the public sector.

Dr. Metzenbaum's talk will focus on how we, as government leaders, can:

- Address the challenge of effective execution of public policies and to rebuild public trust in government,
- Work in partnership with educational institutions, governmental organizations, business groups, and public interest enterprises,
- Sponsor research on government performance, make actionable recommendations for policy and implementation, and
- Provide a forum for discussion of new ideas and tools to strengthen policy execution at all levels of government.
