

Cabinet Agencies' Performance Audit Action Item(s) & Status

Department of Commerce State Energy Program American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

Agencies included in the performance audit: Department of Commerce.

SAO Issues Summary:

- 1. Program administrators followed many of the sound practices we identified. However, in an effort to meet tight federal deadlines, they did not follow some important practices in awarding the funds.
- 2. The State Energy Office did not require or receive all the information it will need to ensure it can appropriately monitor and oversee these projects.
- 3. Commerce did not meet a goal to loan two-thirds of the Recovery Act funds provided to the Loan and Grant Program, which will reduce by \$ 8.5 million, the amount of funds available for future energy projects.
