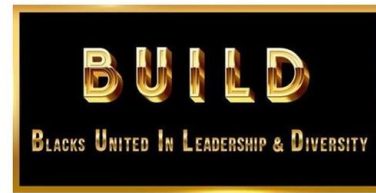


Washington State Business Resource Groups
